



## The 19th Quilt Nihon Exhibition 2027

**Entry Term :** July 1st—23rd, 2027

**Eligibility :** No restrictions

**Entry :**

Category A : Traditional (Inspired and based on traditional ideas.)

Category B : Contemporary (Demonstrate originality and independent ideas.)

Category C : Miniature (Quilts must measure less than or equal to 60 cm on each side. All aspects of the quilt are reduced in scale and miniaturization.)

### **Regulations Entry Rules :**

- Category A,B : Size of the work must not be smaller than 120cm (47 1/4in.) and must not exceed 230cm (90 1/2in.) both in the width and length (maximum 230×230cm, minimum 120×120cm).
- Category C : Finished quilt must be smaller than 60×60cm vertically and horizontally. If blocks are used, they should be no larger than 10 cm square.
- Work must consist of a top, the batting, the backing and these three layers must be held together by hand - or machine quilting or other methods.
- Work must be completed after July, 2025 and must be original. Any works that have appeared in any copyrighted publications (such as magazines, books or newspapers), any contests, any competitions, and exhibitions (excluding private exhibitions), and/or any internet sites other than quilters' own site are not eligible.
- Quilts must be constructed and quilted by the person named on the entry form.
- Entries are limited to two per person.
- Framed work is not acceptable.

### **Examination fee :**

- First judging (photo screening): Free of charge
- Second round of judging (actual product judging): 9900 JPY for Category A and B, and 6600JPY for Category C
- Please note that if you are ordering from outside Japan, we will charge you separately for any shipping costs incurred, such as when returning the quilt.

- **Minister of Education, Culture, Sports, Science and Technology Encouragement Award (Gold Award)** : Selected 1 work each from all categories (A, B and C) as Gold Awards, and pick 1 work from them as this Award.  
...Monetary Award of 200,000 JPY.
- **Governor of Tokyo Award (Gold Award)** : Selected 1 work each from all categories (A, B and C) as Gold Awards, and pick 1 work from them as this Award.  
... Monetary Award of 100,000 JPY.
- **Silver Award** : Given to 1 work each from Category A, B and C.  
...Monetary Award of 50,000 JPY.
- **Bronze Award** : Given to 1 work each from Category A, B and C.  
...Monetary Award of 30,000 JPY.
- **Jurors' Encouragement Award** : Given to 1 work from all Categories (A, B and C) by each juror to encourage one's future creative activity.  
... Commemorative items.
- **Publisher's Award (Quilts Japan Award, other)** : Given to 1 work each from Category A, B and C per publishers. Each awarded work will appear on awarding publisher's print media.  
...Free subscription for 2 years.
- **Corporate Award(NIHON VOUGE CO., LTD. Award, etc.)** : The corporations that support this exhibition select 1 work from all categories.  
...Commemorative items.
- **Honorable Mention** : Approximately 25 works will be selected from all Categories.
